## Anti-doping policy

### Policy purpose

West Australian Sports Development Association Inc. ("WASDA") is committed to the elimination of drugs in sport at all levels. WASDA does not condone the use of drugs in sport and fully supports the World Anti-Doping Code, the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority Act 2006 (Cth), the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority Regulations 2006 (Cth) (including the National Anti-Doping scheme), and the ongoing efforts to eradicate doping in sport in Australia and throughout the world. WASDA recognises the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority ("ASADA") as the national organisation responsible for Australia.

### Policy details

WASDA will not tolerate any member who tests positive for any substance listed on the World Anti-Doping Agency ("WADA") Prohibited List as issued from time to time by WADA whilst they are a member of WASDA.

WASDA will not tolerate any person who has made application for assistance from the Association testing positive for any substance listed on the WADA Prohibited List as issued from time to time by WADA whether before or after application has been made.

### Consequences of breach of policy

Any member who tests positive for any substance listed on the WADA Prohibited List shall be given notice that their membership will be terminated with effect from seven days after the date of the notice. This is a strict liability matter and there is no recourse for review of the decision other than if any banning as a result of a positive test is subsequently reversed by WADA, ASADA or the Court of Arbitration for Sport ("CAS").

Any applicant who tests positive for any substance listed on the World Anti-Doping Agency ("WADA") Prohibited List whether before or after application has been made and/or accepted will be given notice that their application has been voided as a consequence of the positive test and that any assistance already provided is immediately repayable to the Association. This is a strict liability matter and there is no recourse for review of the decision other than if any banning as a result of a positive test is subsequently reversed by WADA, ASADA or CAS.
